Discuss proposed changes to Dane County MI zoning district and salvage yards.

Roger Lane summarized the issue with the zoning code regarding salvage yards and language that was omitted by error when the code was redone a few years ago. He also noted that the current Dane County Zoning Ordinance doesn't align with DOT salvage licenses. The DNR and DOT now have licenses for these facilities that make the Dane County licenses obsolete.

Q: This proposal also gets rid of the Dane County annual inspection because that is part of the license. Do DNR and DOT have regular inspections?

A: I am sure they do, but I don't know.

Q: What is the impact with Dane County no longer doing the licensing?

A: Nothing really, DNR and DOT licenses are required.

Q: Towns expect annual salvage yard inspections.

A: Even if inspections are not required, towns can request an inspection. We are happy to do that if notified.

Dane County staff will work on the wording for the ordinance amendment and draft a more formal memo. When that is done, they will connect with DCTA again.
