Presentations and Educational Sessions

- 1. Grant writing
- 2. Emergencies (eg, Wisconsin Disaster Fund) Responding to increasing traffic, including cut-through traffic
- 3. Identifying locations for traffic safety improvements (eg, flashing stop signs, reflective poles, street lights, etc)
- 4. Planning for changing economics of agriculture (eg, land value and solar fields)
- 5. Planning for climate change
- 6. Ways to approach boundary agreements and annexations
- 7. Remote monitoring of town buildings (wireless thermostats, security cameras)

Model Ordinances and Procedures

- 1. For each model we can have a working group of people from various towns to use their experiences to create a model. We can have an attorney review the model before sharing with towns.

- Model driveway access ordinance Straightforward guide to what is needed to reduce speed limits (started)
- 4. Model process for conditional use permit applications
- 5. Work with Dane County staff to add Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) to more areas of the zoning code

Work with Others

- 1. Dane County Zoning: additional ordinance revisions for conditional uses
- 2. Greater Madison Metropolitan Planning Organization: identifying dangerous intersections/roads, roads with the most speeding, truck traffic, etc.
