Model Ordinances and Procedures

3. Model driveway access ordinance
Straightforward guide to what is needed to reduce speed limits (started)
4. Model process for conditional use permit applications
5. Work with Dane County staff to add Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) to more areas of the zoning code

Work with Others

1. Dane County Zoning: additional ordinance revisions for conditional uses
2. Greater Madison Metropolitan Planning Organization: identifying dangerous intersections/roads, roads with the most speeding, truck traffic, etc.
