"EC" Report Update

Environmental Corridors

Generally contiguous systems of open space and environmentally sensitive areas within urban service areas that are protected from development

- Environmentally sensitive lands
- Natural and cultural resources
- Lands for stormwater management, recreational use, or open space functions














EC Report Update

Estimated Environmental Corridors

(Formerly: Protection Areas)

Preliminary estimates of lands that would be required to be designated as Environmental Corridor if brought into an urban service area

- Environmentally sensitive lands
- Natural and cultural resources
- Lands for stormwater management, recreational use, or open space functions














Future EC

Voluntary Environmental Corridors

(Formerly: Stewardship Areas)

Lands recommended for **voluntary** inclusion in Environmental Corridors that provide important benefits but lack legal protections

- Old-growth woodlands
- Potentially restorable wetlands / hydric soils
- 0.2% annual chance floodplain
- Ice Age Trail Corridor / NRAB
- Internally drained areas


